# News from the Property Department <u>January 2020</u>

In the near future, a new security measure will be installed. At the present time one may access the church through three doors using one standard code. New door code panels will be installed on the three current doors and a new panel on the bell tower door. Each family or individual will be able to choose their own code. Our one code system is not particularly effective because so many individuals have the code. The installation of personal codes will improve the safety of our church members significantly. The new system will be zoned so that, as an example, the parents of PREP schoolers will only be able to access the porta cache door. This ensures the safety of the congregation during services and other events as well as the safety of PREP children and staff.
