OUTREACH PROJECT CHILDREN'S GATHERING SUNDAY FOR LCM FOOD BOX

First Christian Church is a giving church with an emphasis on Outreach in the community. As a means to help our children develop a giving heart and benefit the LCM Food Box, we are initiating a Children's Gathering Sunday each third Sunday of the month. The Congregation is encouraged to bring a non-perishable food item for the Food Box to the worship service and, right after the Children's Sermon, the children will go out in the Congregation and gather up all the donated goods and bring them up to the Food Box basket that will be located at the front of the church.

We feel that it is important to get our children involved in outreach and this fun activity each third Sunday of the month will be a teaching moment as well as benefit the Food Box.
