right to gather together, I hope you will understand that we will continue with our current format by NOT gathering in person for worship during the month of May. Thank you for being so gracious as we minimize the risk for illness and continue to worship online from our homes.

When the time comes to gather together (and, like you, I can't wait for this to happen) there will be many steps to consider. There is the chance that how we do church logistically will be a little different. The goal is to safely return to "normal" activities once the Covid-19 numbers begin a constant decline and the state/local steps taken prove successful. Re-opening the church may be a slow process.

First Christian Church is fortunate to have been approved by our bank for the government PPP financial support. We have received the loan which is funding two months to pay salaries for the church and PREP school teachers.
