

Day Camp 2021 will be a bit different than in years past! Here are important changes you need to know!

Remember, Mini Camp is for 4 and 5 year olds (4 years old by September 1, 2020) and Day Camp is for kids who finish 1st – 5th grade in the 2020/2021 school year. We also need junior counselors (those who finished 6th-12th grade in the 2020/2021 school year) and adult helpers! Everyone signs up online! Spread the word to friends and family!

The Day Camp Committee includes Lauren Warren, Meme Woodruff, Richard Emerson, Evan Dolive, Miranda Dolive, and Amanda Grimes. Our theme this year is Fruits of the Spirit, Galatians 5:22-23!

Camp will be Monday-Friday, June 14-18. Arrival time at the church each day is 8:15-8:30, and pickup is at the church at 12:30 for BOTH Mini Camp and Day Camp.

- Mini Campers must be 4 years old by Sept 1, 2020.
- Day Camp activities will include fishing, canoeing, nature walk, singing, worship, Bible study, arts & crafts, outreach, lawn games, and EATING! (snack provided by the church and sack lunch provided by the campers)
- Due to the COVID pandemic, we will not be swimming or having our Thursday picnic and sleepover.
- It is very important that everyone involved in Mini or Day Camp sign up online in April .This includes campers, junior counselors, counselors, AND purple-shirt adult helpers. We are using an awesome app called ProCare for sign-in and sign-

out every day, and we have to get the app updated by the time camp rolls around!

- This year the fee for Mini Campers is \$20, and the fee for Day Campers is \$40. Our church is offering camp scholarships, so let Lauren or the church office know if you need one!
- If it rains during the week of camp, Mini Camp can still meet at the church; we will not hold Day Camp in heavy rain, especially if there is lightning.
- We will take several COVID precautions this year. 1. We will be staying in our grade groups (no mass gatherings). 2. We will wear face masks on the bus- you will get a custom Day Camp lanyard for your mask! 3. Snacks provided by the church will be individually packaged.
- Since we have to stay in our individual groups, a few things will look different during our camp day. We will still have chapel and worship time each morning, and we will share our grade chants with everyone through the FCC Day Camp Facebook page.
