Our food pantry needs to be replenished! The following items are needed:

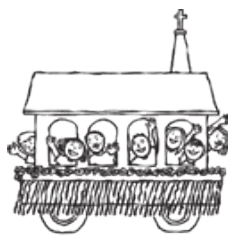
Canned vegetables Canned fruit
