Property Report:

At the last board meeting, the property department presented the possible need to replace the sanctuary and adult wing HVAC. The board approved an extension of the current loan by \$100,000. The approval proved fortuitous because the system failed soon after the meeting. The install total was \$72,218.

At the time of the garage sale, there was a failure in a water fountain in the children's wing. Because of the failure, some rooms received water damage. The total repair was \$48,686. Insurance covered \$45,000.

The air conditioner in the parsonage failed and was replaced. Total replacement cost was \$4,574.

The 8.5 ton unit that primarily cools the landings is working at the monent. We did get a quote for that repair, when necessary, of \$12,730.

Monies received from the garage sale and the remainder of the loan will hopefully put FCC in a fairly good situation to take care of any other issues that may occur.
